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General:

Access to the backstage areas is available to the visiting Company from Midday except on Matinee days. If this is deemed to be an issue, please contact us to discuss as earlier access may incur additional staff costs.

Parking:

Please note that we do not have any on site parking facilities. There is a pay car park for cars only just around the corner from the theatre, but we have no facilities for vans, minibuses etc to be parked near to the theatre.

The nearest paid car park is at the Grand Arcade which is open 24/7. This car park is quite expensive.

The council runs 'park and ride' buses until 20:00 from several locations around the city.

There are a number of side streets where parking is free for the day, all of these are 15-20 mins walk from the theatre.

One of the best streets to use is <u>Adams Road</u>, off Grange Road.

Internet:

Internet and WiFi connections are available backstage and on stage please ask a member of the Tech Dept for access password.

Stage:

The Stage is flat (no rake) and has a glazed black ply surface. Visiting Companies may fix directly into the floor with screws at the discretion of the in-house staff.

Colour

The Cambridge Arts Theatre carries a stock of Lee and Rosco Supergel filters from which a colour call may be prepared in advance at a cost of £50.00. Colour not in stock, other brands of colour filter or large quantities of filter can be supplied, and will be charged for at cost in addition to the colour call charge.

The M7CL - 48 is in the Sound Control Room at the rear of the Circle and is not moveable. The window of the Sound Control Room slides back for live sound mixing.

Our radio microphones are available for use if available, at a nominal charge of £10.00 per mic per day. If any damage is incurred then the visiting company will be charged at cost for any repair. The system uses either rechargeable AA batteries (in house) or alkaline batteries which must be provided by the visiting company.

The use of the radio mics must be pre-arranged with the Head of Technical prior to your arrival.

Radio mic licensing:

We hold a site licence for the following frequencies:

Ch69. Ch38, Ch39, Ch40 – for touring equipment (not all frequencies available and are constrained by the Digital Switchover) Ch40, Ch42 and Ch43 – Cambridge Arts Theatre Equipment

Mixing positions:

There is also a mixing position at the rear of the stalls, maximum space available is 3000mm x 2000mm

At the venues discretion we may ask you to position the desk off centre to allow the sale of surrounding seats to maximise Box Office.

There is space in our sound control room or in prompt corner to site a small touring sound desk and associated equipment.

Prompt Desk:

Prompt desk with paging facility located in stage left wing. 14x Q-light circuits (patchable), intercom and video relay. Full show relay (audio and video) to all areas.

Dressing Rooms:

We have 8 dressing rooms and a band room. Three dressing rooms are large (up to 8 people) and three are small (2 to 3 people). There is also an accessible dressing room with ensuite at stage level. The band room can be used as 2 dressing rooms if needs be (up to 8 people in each). Some of the dressing rooms have showers and toilets ensuite, other showers and toilet facilities are available close by.

There is no designated visiting company office.

There is a small kitchenette with microwave and fridge in the Green Room area with Tea and Coffee making facilities.

Wardrobe:

There is a wardrobe room and a laundry room with 2 washing machines, 2 tumble dryers, iron and ironing board.

Please note that dryers and Hot boxes cannot be left on overnight. If left on they will be switched off on building lockdown.
